SB 1130 Firearms in Motor Vehicles by Senator Peaden

Creates the "Preservation and Protection of the Right to Keep and Bear Arms in Motor Vehicles Act of 2008." Prohibits a public or private entity from prohibiting a customer, employee, or invitee from possessing any legally owned firearm that is lawfully possessed and locked inside or locked to a private motor vehicle in a parking lot.

Provides for immunity from civil actions for public or private entities or employers based on actions or inactions taken in compliance with the act. Provides exceptions to such immunity.

Requires the Attorney General to enforce the protections of the act on behalf of any customer, employee, or invitee aggrieved under the act. (See bill for details)
