SB 1192

Vessel and Personal Watercraft Safety  
by Senator Rich

Provides that a personal watercraft may not be operated by a person under 16 years of age or by a person that does not hold a boating safety identification card. Revises the requirements relating to the boating safety course required for leasing or renting a vessel or personal watercraft from a livery. (See bill for details)
