SB 1194

### Sexual Battery on a Minor by Senator Ring

Provides for the time period for commencing a civil action based upon an act that constitutes sexual battery upon a minor to be tolled until the victim becomes 18 years of age or during any period of time in which it is determined by a licensed medical practitioner, or a mental health professional otherwise licensed in this state for the treatment of mental, emotional, or behavioral disorders, that it is medically inadvisable for the victim to disclose information or confront the alleged perpetrator.

Provides that the time period of limitation for commencing a prosecution for sexual battery upon a minor does not run during the time the victim is younger than 18 years of age or during any period of time in which it is determined by a licensed medical practitioner, or a mental health professional otherwise licensed in this state for the treatment of mental, emotional, or behavioral disorders, that it is medically inadvisable for the victim to disclose information or confront the alleged perpetrator.
