

## **SENATE BILL SUMMARY**

### SB 1310 Sellers of Travel by Senator Baker

Revises registration fees for sellers of travel who certify their business activities under specified provisions. Requires sellers of travel to annually certify their business activities by filing a disclosure statement with the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services that accurately represents the scope of the seller's business activities. Revises requirements related to the performance bond that must accompany registration or an application for registration.

Provides that it is a violation of the Florida Sellers Travel Act to offer to sell travel or provide any travel-related service to a purchaser traveling to or from any terrorist state without disclosing such business activities in a certification filed with the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services and to violate any state or federal law restricting or prohibiting commerce with terrorist states.
