SB 1328

State Work Opportunity Tax Credit/Felons
by Senator Siplin

Provides an additional credit against the corporate income tax, beginning January 1, 2009, for a business hiring a person who has been convicted of a felony if the hiring is within 3 years after a person's release from a state prison or if the person has been convicted of a felony and is on community control or probation for the commission of a felony.

Requires a business filing for such credit to apply for and receive certification from the Agency for Workforce Innovation that the employee for whom this credit is claimed meets the required criteria. (See bill for details)
