SB 1370

Florida Patient Safety Corporation
by the Committee on Health Regulation

Revises provisions related to the Florida Patient Safety Corporation. Authorizes the corporation to create and dissolve advisory committees upon a majority vote of the board of directors. Requires the Agency for Health Care Administration and the Department of Health to make adverse incident reports available to designated agents of the corporation. Requires the corporation to evaluate the effects of the sharing of electronic health records on patient safety. Deletes responsibilities related to the provision of access to a library of evidence-based medicine and patient safety practices. (See bill for details)
