SB 1390

Public Records/Sale of Ephedrine  
by Senator Saunders

Provides an exemption from public records requirements for information concerning the retail sale of ephedrine, pseudoephedrine, or phenylpropanolamine stored in the written or electronic logbook of a retail distributor or in the centralized real-time electronic logbook maintained by the Department of Law Enforcement. Provides for future legislative review and repeal under the Open Government Sunset Review Act. (See bill for details)
