

## **SENATE BILL SUMMARY**

### SB 1412 Public Moneys and Property/Sports Teams by Senator Bennett

Prohibits governmental entities from spending public funds in aid of a professional sports team, to pay for a facility used or intended to be used for such a team, or for a sporting event of such a team unless the expenditure has been approved by a majority vote of the registered electors residing within the jurisdictional boundaries of the governmental entity. Provides for the ad valorem taxation of property owned by a governmental entity if the property is used by a private entity for a nonexempt purpose. (See bill for details)
