

## **SENATE BILL SUMMARY**

SB 1430

Sexual Predators/Sexual Offenders/Public Safety  
by Senator Aronberg

Revises provisions relating to payment of court related fees, charges, and costs to allow indigent sexual predators to defer payment of all or part of the costs.

Requires that the sheriff or chief of police notify any library within a 1-mile radius of the residence of a sexual predator. Prohibits a sexual predator from working or volunteering at a library or business where children regularly congregate.

Requires the Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) and other specified agencies to consider eliminating or modifying two dates on or after which a person must be classified as a sexual offender or a sexual predator. Directs the FDLE to determine the effect that the elimination or modification of these dates will have on the FDLE and other agencies. Directs the FDLE to present a report of its findings to the Legislature. (See bill for details)
