

## **SENATE BILL SUMMARY**

### SB 1458 School Food Service Programs by Senator Wise

Requires the expansion of school district breakfast programs to middle and high schools by the beginning of the 2010-2011 school year. Provides that universal free school breakfasts be available to schools in which 80 percent or more of the students are eligible for free or reduced-price meals.

Requires that information be communicated to students and parents through school announcements and written notices. Authorizes the Department of Education to develop an incentive program to encourage student participation. (See bill for details)
