SB 1634 Wastewater Management by Senator Bennett

Provides that when a health advisory that prohibits swimming in beach waters is issued on the basis of the results of the bacteriological sampling of waters or when departmental rules or another law requires issuance of a health advisory that prohibits swimming in beach waters on the basis of such results, the Wastewater Compliance Evaluation Section of the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) shall identify the source of the sewage contaminants.

Requires the DEP, within 5 days after discovering that a wastewater facility is in violation of provisions governing pollution control, to provide written notification of each violation to each county and municipality that is within a 5-mile radius of such facility. (See bill for details)
