

## **SENATE BILL SUMMARY**

### SB 1982 Cleanup of Contaminated Petroleum Sites by Senator Baker

Increases public funding for the restoration of certain sites contaminated by petroleum. Provides requirements concerning preapproved site rehabilitation agreements that govern submittal of invoices to the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and payment of subcontractors.

Revises provisions relating to the Florida Petroleum Liability and Restoration Insurance Program and increases the amount of funds available under the program for certain incidents or discharges. Provides criteria concerning the sites that are eligible for additional funds. Prohibits reimbursements for expenses incurred outside the petroleum cleanup preapproval program administered by the DEP. (See bill for details)
