

## SENATE BILL SUMMARY

### SB 2016 Public Lodging and Food Service Establishments by Senator Aronberg

Eliminates the requirement for the Division of Hotels and Restaurants to assist the State Fire Marshal in updating the Florida Fire Prevention Code. Eliminates the requirement for the division to enforce the code in conducting its inspections.

Removes a time limit for obtaining food service manager certification after employment. Deletes the requirement that a transient establishment maintain a copy on its premises of the provisions regulating lodging and food service establishments, and membership campgrounds.

Repeals the provision relating to public lodging establishment room rate posting and filing requirements, room rate advertisement requirements, and related exemptions and penalties. Deletes a requirement for the division to notify local firesafety officials or the State Fire Marshal of violations of rules. Revises the public lodging establishment classifications to include roominghouses.

Requires that public food service establishments be supplied with potable water and provide adequate sanitary facilities for the accommodation of its employees.

Authorizes the division to levy sanctions for failing to comply with final orders of the division. Authorizes the division to require payment of outstanding fines before renewing or issuing a license. (See bill for details)
