SB 2092 Florida Retirement System by Senator Hill

Redefines the term "special risk member" for the purposes of the Florida Retirement System to include, effective July 1, 2008, any member who is employed by a public acute care hospital that serves as a trauma center and provides treatment to members of the public who have deadly or crippling infectious diseases, who are accused of or convicted of serious violent crimes, who have been subjected to hazardous materials or biological or chemical agents as a result of terrorism or industrial accidents, or who have diseases the treatment of which requires interventions with extremely toxic substances. Revises criteria for membership in the special risk class to include such members. (See bill for details)
