

SENATE BILL SUMMARY

SB 2096 Department of Transportation by Senator Bullard

Directs the Department of Transportation (DOT) to maintain training programs in the field of transportation engineering and leading to licensure as a professional engineer for DOT employees and prospective employees who are graduates from an approved engineering school, college, or university.

Directs the DOT to maintain training programs for DOT employees providing broad practical experience and enhanced knowledge in the areas of right-of-way property management, real estate appraisal, and business valuation relating to the department's right-of-way acquisition activities.

Eliminates the requirement to annually update the Florida Transportation Plan. Deletes the requirement to develop a short-range component of the Florida Transportation Plan. Eliminates the requirement to develop an annual performance report. (See bill for details)
