

## **SENATE BILL SUMMARY**

SB 2116

Trust Funds/Department of Children and Family Services  
by Senator Peaden

Terminates the Child Advocacy Trust Fund and the Refugee Assistance Trust Fund within the Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS).

Provides for the administration of the Administrative Trust Fund, the Alcohol, Drug Abuse, and Mental Health Trust Fund, the Child Welfare Training Trust Fund, the Domestic Violence Trust Fund, the Federal Grants Trust Fund, the Grants and Donations Trust Fund, the Operations and Maintenance Trust Fund, the Social Services Block Grant Trust Fund, the Welfare Transition Trust Fund, and the Working Capital Trust Fund by the DCFS.

Revises the date for reversion of specified balances in the Tobacco Settlement Trust Fund.

Provides for deposit of proceeds derived from additional court costs imposed in cases of certain crimes against minors into the Grants and Donations Trust Fund of the DCFS. Provides for the appropriation of those funds to the DCFS for the specific purpose of funding children's advocacy centers. Provides that funds shall be disbursed to the Florida Network of Children's Advocacy Centers, Inc., for the purpose of providing community-based services that augment, but do not duplicate, services provided by state agencies and exempts those funds from the service charge imposed on income of a revenue nature deposited in trust funds.
