

SENATE BILL SUMMARY

SB 2202 Career Service Employees by Senator Dean

Revises requirements for disciplining an employee and which employees are subject to certain personnel actions. Specifies the requirements for achieving permanent status in the Career Service System. Revises criteria for certain rules and procedures for the suspension, reduction in pay, transfer, layoff, demotion, and dismissal of career service employees. Revises provisions relating to the applicability of layoff procedures, and provides that the grievance process is available to all career service employees.

Provides that a career service employee who has permanent status and who is subject to a lay off, involuntary transfer of more than 50 miles by highway, among other specified actions, shall receive written notice of such action within 10 days before the date such action is to be taken. Revises procedures relating to a specified appeal filed with the Public Employees Relations Commission. Revises which actions must be reviewed without consideration of any other case or set of facts.
