Judicial Sales/Real or Personal Property by Senator Baker

Permits judicial sales of real or personal property under an order or judgment to be conducted by electronic means. Requires that electronic sales comply with specified procedures. Requires the clerk of the court to provide the public with access to computer terminals for electronic sales. Authorizes clerks to receive electronic payments and deposits. Provides a \$100 service charge to be received by clerks for sales conducted by electronic means. (See bill for details)
