SB 68

Nicole Hornstein Act/Equine Activities  
by Senator Aronberg

Requires any equine rider who is under 16 years of age to wear a helmet that meets applicable American Society of Testing and Materials standards for protective headgear used in horseback riding when such activity occurs in public locations. Specified locations include, but are not limited to, public roadways, rights-of-way, public equestrian and public recreational trails, public parks or preserves, or public school sites. Requires persons renting or leasing equines for riding by a person under 16 years of age to provide a helmet if the minor does not have one. Provides exceptions for competing or performing in certain shows or events. (See bill for details)
