SB 460
Adoption
by Senator Rich

Provides that a homosexual is eligible to adopt a child if the child has resided with the person, the child recognizes the person proposing to adopt as the child's parent, and the best interest of the child will be served. Provides that a homosexual is eligible to adopt if the child's parents are deceased and the person proposing to adopt the child is the guardian. Provides that certain provisions apply only with respect to a petition, declaration, or will or codicil that is executed on or after July 1, 2009. (See bill for details)
