SB 644
Veterans
by Senator Fasano

Revises an exemption from county or municipality license or permit fees required for improvements to a dwelling owned by a disabled veteran if the improvements are for the purpose of making the dwelling safe.

Deletes the \$100,000 monetary limitation on the amount of general revenue deposited into the State Home for Veterans Trust Fund from the sale of special license plates.

Authorizes an eligible student who receives benefits as a veteran who served on active duty in the Armed Forces after September 11, 2001, to one deferment of college tuition and fees each academic year and an additional deferment each time there is a delay in receipt of benefits.
