SB 736 Traffic Control Synchronization by Senator Garcia

Provides for the synchronization of traffic lights by the Department of Transportation (DOT) and the traffic control authority within each county and municipality by January 1, 2012.

Requires the DOT to establish performance benchmarks in order to optimize traffic flow using best practices for traffic-light synchronization by the state, counties, and municipalities. Requires monitoring and reporting to the public by the DOT. (See bill for details)
