SB 892

Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services by Senator Bennett

Authorizes the Agency for Health Care Administration, in consultation with the Department of Children and Family Services, to license facilities that provide services as an integrated adult mental health crisis stabilization unit and addictions receiving facility. Specifies that such facilities may provide services to adults who are 18 years of age or older and who fall into one or more of the following categories: an adult meeting the requirements for voluntary admission for mental health treatment or substance abuse treatment, an adult meeting the criteria for involuntary examination for mental illness, or an adult meeting the criteria for involuntary admission for substance abuse impairment.
