SB 908  
Restoration of Civil Rights/Clemency  
by Senator Wilson

Proposes an amendment to the State Constitution to authorize the Legislature to enact laws to suspend or remit fines and forfeitures, grant reprieves not exceeding 60 days, restore civil rights, and commute punishments, except in cases of treason. Such laws may apply to previously committed crimes. (See bill for details)
