

## **SENATE BILL SUMMARY**

### SB 1114 Highway Safety Violations by Senator Richter

Provides an additional \$65 penalty for violations of provisions that require traffic to stop for a school bus, prohibit racing on highways, and prohibit reckless driving.

Requires the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to identify a person who has committed a second violation within 12 months after the first violation of not stopping for a school bus, racing on highways, or reckless driving. Requires such person to complete a driver improvement course within 90 days after receiving notice from the department.

Provides for distribution of funds to trauma centers. (See bill for details)
