SB 1402

Drug Prescription Information/Commercial Use
by Senator Aronberg

Prohibits the licensure, transfer, use, or sale of records of information relating to drug prescriptions containing patient-identifiable and prescriber-identifiable data. Provides that the act does not prohibit certain activities involving prescription information or the collection, use, transfer, or sale of medical information about an individual for commercial purposes, identified by zip code, geographic region, or medical specialty, if that information does not identify the patient or prescriber.

Provides that a violation of the act is a deceptive and unfair trade practice. Provides a penalty. (See bill for details)
