Amendment (with directory and title amendments)

Between lines 791 and 792, insert:

(10) (a) Whenever an insurance company makes a total loss settlement on a motor vehicle, the owner or lienholder of the motor vehicle shall forward the properly endorsed certificate of title to the insurance company within 15 days after receipt of the settlement funds.

(b) If an insurance company is unable to obtain the properly endorsed certificate of title within 30 days after disbursement of total loss settlement funds, the insurance company, on a form provided by the department and signed under penalty of perjury, may request the department to issue a salvage certificate of title for the vehicle. The request shall include and document that the requestor has made at least two

17 written attempts to obtain the certificate of title, and shall
18 include the fees applicable to issuance of a salvage certificate
19 of title.

20 (c) The department, upon receipt of a properly endorsed
21 certificate of title or a properly executed request under
22 paragraph (b), shall issue a salvage certificate of title for
23 the vehicle in the name of the insurance company.
