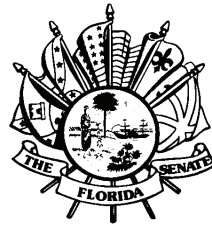

# BILLS ON THE CALENDAR

## SENATE BILLS ON SECOND READING

### POLICY AND STEERING COMMITTEE ON COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY [CPSC] GROUPING

**CS/SB 844 (2R) by the Committee on Criminal Justice,  
Senator Bennett and others—**

**Insurance;** Expands the definition of "affiliated party" to include certain third-party marketers. Includes family members of insurance agents in a prohibition related to the transaction of life insurance. Prohibits the Department of Financial Services from issuing certain licenses in certain circumstances. Increases the administrative fine that may be imposed for each willful violation of the offenses of twisting and churning, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2010.

*Reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Banking and Insurance, and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Criminal Justice*

### POLICY AND STEERING COMMITTEE ON ENERGY, ENVIRONMENT, AND LAND USE [EPSC] GROUPING

**CS/CS/SB 350 (2R) by the Committees on General  
Government Appropriations, Agriculture and Senator Dean—**

**Tomato Food Safety;** Requires minimum food safety standards for producing, harvesting, packing, and repacking tomatoes. Authorizes the DOACS to inspect tomato farms, greenhouses, and packinghouses or repackers. Provides a presumption that tomatoes introduced into commerce are safe for human consumption under certain circumstances. Revises duties of the Division of Fruit and Vegetables for tomato food safety inspections, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2010.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Agriculture and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on General Government Appropriations*

**CS/SB 610 (2R) by the Committee on Governmental Oversight  
and Accountability, Senator Fasano and others—**

**Collective Bargaining for Certain Public Employees;** Specifies that for purposes of resolving an impasse the sheriff, the tax collector, the property appraiser, the supervisor of elections, and the clerk of the circuit court are each deemed the "legislative body" for their respective employees, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2010.

*Reported favorably, with one amendment, by the Committee on Community Affairs and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability*

## POLICY AND STEERING COMMITTEE ON GOVERNMENTAL OPERATIONS [GPSC] GROUPING

**CS/SB 464 (2R) by the Committee on Transportation and  
Economic Development Appropriations and Senator  
Fasano—**

**Military Affairs/Leave of Absence;** Amends specified provision relating to provisions authorizing leave of absence for officers and employees of the state or counties, municipalities, or political subdivisions who are commissioned reserve officers or reserve enlisted personnel in the United States military or naval service or who are members of the National Guard. Provides for the appointment of a second Assistant Adjutant General for the Florida National Guard Army, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2010.

*Reported favorably by the Committees on Military Affairs and Domestic Security, and Governmental Oversight and Accountability, and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations*

### POLICY AND STEERING COMMITTEE ON SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY [SPSC] GROUPING

**CS/SB 86 (2R) by the Committee on Judiciary and Senator  
Sobel—**

**Excuse from Jury Service;** Expands parental eligibility to be excused from jury service. Authorizes a presiding judge to excuse a practicing psychologist from jury service. Effective Date: 07/01/2010.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Judiciary*

**SB 166 (2R) by Senator Wise—**

**Prescribed Pancreatic Enzyme Supplements/Use;** Authorizes certain K-12 students to use prescribed pancreatic enzyme supplements under certain circumstances. Requires the State Board of Education to adopt rules. Provides for indemnification. Effective Date: 07/01/2010.

*Reported favorably by the Committees on Education Pre-K - 12, Health Regulation, and Education Pre-K - 12 Appropriations*

**SB 208 (2R) by Senator Oelrich—**

**Community College Student Fees/Transportation;** Authorizes community college boards of trustees to establish a transportation access fee. Limits the amount of the fee. Provides a timeframe for a fee increase and implementation of an increase. Prohibits the inclusion of the fee in calculating the amount a student receives under Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program awards. Effective Date: 07/01/2010.

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Higher Education and reported favorably by the Committee on Higher Education Appropriations*

**CS/SB 436 (2R) by the Committee on Higher Education, Senator Baker and others—**

**Community Colleges/Palm Beach/Seminole;** Amends a specified provision relating to educational institutes. Conforms provisions. Renames Palm Beach Community College and Seminole Community College as "Palm Beach State College" and "Seminole State College of Florida," respectively. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Higher Education*

**POLICY AND STEERING COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS [WPSC] GROUPING**

**SJR 2 (2R) by Senator Gaetz and others—**

**Class Size Requirements for Public Schools;** Proposes amendments to the State Constitution to revise class size requirements for public schools and to provide an effective date.

*Reported favorably by the Committees on Education Pre-K - 12 and Policy & Steering Committee on Ways and Means*

**CS/CS/SB 644 (2R) by the Committees on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations, Governmental Oversight and Accountability and Senator Justice—**

**Direct-support Org./Department of Military Affairs;** Authorizes the direct-support organization to support the processing of requests from the Soldiers and Airmen Assistance Program or similar programs. Requires the direct-support organization to submit its annual budget and financial reports to the DMA. Requires the financial committee of the board of directors of the direct-support organization for the DMA to review the financial transactions of the program quarterly, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2010.

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Military Affairs and Domestic Security, and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability, and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations*

**CS/SB 1624 (2R) by the Committee on Criminal and Civil Justice Appropriations and Senator Crist—**

**SB 1626 (2R) by Senator Baker—**

**Ringling Investment Trust Fund/DMS;** Terminates the Ringling Investment Trust Fund within the Department of Management Services. Provides for the disposition of balances in and revenues of the trust fund. Prescribes procedures for terminating the trust fund. Effective Date: 07/01/2010.

**CS/SB 1628 (2R) by the Committee on General Government Appropriations and Senator Baker—**

**Federal Grants Trust Fund/DMS;** Creates the Federal Grants Trust Fund within the Department of Management Services. Provides for the purpose of the trust fund and sources of funds. Provides for future review and termination or re-creation of the trust fund. Effective Date: 07/01/2010 if enacted by a 3/5ths vote of the membership of each house of the Legislature.

**CS/SB 1630 (2R) by the Committee on General Government Appropriations and Senator Baker—**

**Audit & Warrant Clearing Trust Fund/DOR;** Re-creates the Audit and Warrant Clearing Trust Fund within the Department of Revenue without modification. Abrogates provisions relating to the termination of the trust fund, to conform. Effective Date: 07/01/2010 if enacted by a 3/5ths vote of the membership of each house of the Legislature.

**SB 1632 (2R) by Senator Fasano—**

**Transportation Revenue Bond Trust Fund/DOT;** Reenacts and amends a specified provision relating to the Transportation Revenue Bond Trust Fund within the Department of Transportation. Provides for future review and termination or re-creation of the trust fund. Effective Date: 07/01/2010 if enacted by a 3/5ths vote of the membership of each house of the Legislature.

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations*

**CS/SB 1634 (2R) by the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations and Senator Fasano—**

**Transportation Governmental Bond Trust Fund/DOT;** Creates the Transportation Governmental Bond Trust Fund within the Department of Transportation. Provides for the purpose of the trust fund and sources of funds. Provides for future review and termination or re-creation of the trust fund. Effective Date: 07/01/2010 if enacted by a 3/5ths vote of the membership of each house of the Legislature.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations*

**CS/SB 1636 (2R) by the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations and Senator Fasano—**

**Trust Funds;** Creates the Clearing Funds Trust Fund within the Department of State. Clarifies provisions requiring that election assessments be transferred to the Elections Commission Trust Fund within the Department of Legal Affairs. Requires that certain funds paid to the Department of State by cable or video providers be deposited into the Clearing Funds Trust Fund rather than the Operating Trust Fund, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2010 if enacted by a 3/5ths vote of the membership of each house of the Legislature.

**CS/SB 1638 (2R) by the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations and Senator Fasano—**

Provides for future review and termination or re-creation of the trust fund. Effective Date: 07/01/2010 if enacted by a 3/5ths vote of the membership of each house of the Legislature.

**CS/SB 1640 (2R) by the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations and Senator Fasano—**

**Florida Forever Trust Fund/DCA;** Re-creates said trust fund within the DCA. Reenacts and amends a specified provision relating to said trust fund. Provides for sources of funds and purposes. Provides for the annual carryforward of funds. Provides for future review and termination or re-creation of the trust fund. Effective Date: 07/01/2010 if enacted by a 3/5ths vote of the membership of each house of the Legislature.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations*

**CS/SB 1642 (2R) by the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations and Senator Fasano—**

**Emergency Response Trust Fund/Military Affairs;** Re-creates the Emergency Response Trust Fund within the Department of Military Affairs without modification. Abrogates the provisions relating to the termination of the trust fund, to conform. Effective Date: 07/01/2010 if enacted by a 3/5ths vote of the membership of each house of the Legislature.

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations*

**CS/SB 1644 (2R) by the Committee on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations and Senator Fasano—**

**Trust Funds/Department of State;** Terminates specified trust funds within the Department of State. Provides for the disposition of balances in and revenues of such trust funds. Prescribes procedures for the termination of such trust funds. Redesignates the Florida Fine Arts Trust Fund within the Division of Cultural Affairs as the Grants and Donations Trust Fund. Effective Date: 07/01/2011.

### **POLICY AND STEERING COMMITTEE ON SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY [SPSC] GROUPING**

**SCR 10 (2R) by Senator Atwater and others—**

**Balanced Federal Budget;** Urges Congress to call a convention for the purpose of proposing amendments to the Constitution of the United States to provide for a balanced federal budget and limit the ability of Congress to dictate to states requirements for the expenditure of federal funds.

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Judiciary*

**CS/SB 530 (2R) by the Committee on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs, Senator Altman and others—**

**Adoption;** Prohibits an adoption agency or entity from making suitability determinations based on, requiring disclosure relating to, or restricting the lawful possession, storage, or use of firearm or ammunition. Provides additional requirements for child-placing agencies. Provides additional rulemaking requirements for the DCFS. Creates additional grounds for denial, suspension, or revocation of a license. Effective Date: Upon becoming law.

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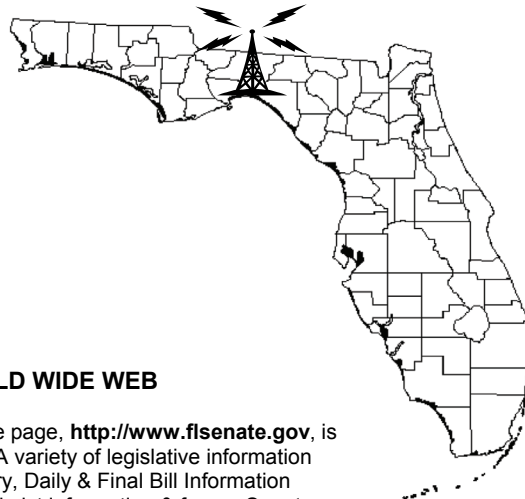
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
