Revises the definition of the term "food service establishment" to exclude domestic violence centers under certain conditions. Effective Date: 07/01/2010.

### CS/CS/SB 998 (SO) by the Committees on Banking and Insurance, Judiciary and Senator Thrasher—

**Trust Administration**; Limits a personal representative's entitlement to payment from a trust of certain estate expenses and obligations. Deletes certain notice requirements relating to court review of a trustee's employment of certain persons. Prohibits state agencies and local governments from requiring the disclosure of certain characteristics of persons associated with certain charitable organizations, trusts, and foundations, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming law except as otherwise provided.


