7 170.201 Special assessments.—

8 (1) In addition to other lawful authority to levy and  
9 collect special assessments, the governing body of a  
10 municipality may levy and collect special assessments to fund  
11 capital improvements and municipal services, including, but not  
12 limited to, fire protection, emergency medical services, garbage  
13 disposal, sewer improvement, street improvement, security of  
14 real property and improvements, and parking facilities. The  
15 governing body of a municipality may apportion costs of such  
16 special assessments based on:

- 17 (a) The front or square footage of each parcel of land; or
- 18 (b) An alternative methodology, so long as the amount of
- 19 the assessment for each parcel of land is not in excess of the

22 Section 3. Section 205.045, Florida Statutes, is amended  
23 to read:

24 205.045 Transfer of administrative duties.—The governing  
 25 body of a municipality that levies a business tax may request  
 26 that the county in which the municipality is located issue the  
 27 municipal receipt and collect the tax thereon. The governing  
 28 body of a county that levies a business tax may request that  
 29 municipalities within the county, the county tax collector or  
 30 other public officer, or any county department issue the county  
 31 receipt and collect the tax thereon. Before any local government  
 32 may issue receipts on behalf of another local government,  
 33 appropriate agreements must be entered into by the affected  
 34 local governments.
