4 Between lines 3827 and 3828, insert:

5 Section 49. Preference to state residents.-

6 (1) Each contract for construction that is funded by state
7 funds must contain a provision requiring the contractor to give
8 preference to the employment of state residents in the
9 performance of the work on the project if state residents have
10 substantially equal qualifications to those of nonresidents. A
11 contract for construction funded by local funds may contain such
12 a provision.

13 (a) As used in this section, the term "substantially equal
14 qualifications" means the qualifications of two or more persons
15 among whom the employer cannot make a reasonable determination
16 that the qualifications held by one person are better suited for

18 persons.

19 (b) A contractor required to employ state residents must
20 contact the Agency for Workforce Innovation to post the
21 contractor's employment needs in the state's job bank system.

22 (2) No contract shall be let to any person refusing to
23 execute an agreement containing the provisions required by this
24 section. However, in work involving the expenditure of federal
25 aid funds, this section may not be enforced in such a manner as
26 to conflict with or be contrary to federal law prescribing a
27 labor preference to honorably discharged soldiers, sailors, or
28 marines, or prohibiting as unlawful any other preference or
29 discrimination among the citizens of the United States.
