Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Between lines 561 and 562

insert:

Section 3. Paragraph (j) of subsection (2) of section 626.221, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

626.221 Examination requirement; exemptions.—

(2) However, no such examination shall be necessary in any of the following cases:

(j) An applicant for license as a customer representative who has earned the designation of Accredited Advisor in Insurance (AAI) from the Insurance Institute of America, the designation of Certified Insurance Counselor (CIC) from the

15 designation of Accredited Customer Service Representative (ACSR)
16 from the Independent Insurance Agents of America, the
17 designation of Certified Professional Service Representative
18 (CPSR) from the National Foundation for Certified Professional
19 Service Representatives, the designation of Certified Insurance
20 Service Representative (CISR) from the Society of Certified
21 Insurance Service Representatives, or the designation of
22 Certified Insurance Representative (CIR) from the National
23 Association of Christian Catastrophe Insurance Adjusters. Also,
24 an applicant for license as a customer representative who has
25 earned an associate degree or bachelor's degree from an
26 accredited college or university with at least 9 academic hours
27 of property and casualty insurance curriculum, or the
28 equivalent, or has earned the designation of Certified Customer
29 Service Representative (CCSR) from the Florida Association of
30 Insurance Agents, or the designation of Registered Customer
31 Service Representative (RCSR) from a regionally accredited
32 postsecondary institution in this state, or the designation of
33 Professional Customer Service Representative (PCSR) from the
34 Professional Career Institute, whose curriculum has been
35 approved by the department and whose curriculum includes
36 comprehensive analysis of basic property and casualty lines of
37 insurance and testing at least equal to that of standard
38 department testing for the customer representative license. The
39 department shall adopt rules establishing standards for the
40 approval of curriculum.
