and insert:

(1) An ~~Any~~ individual who is an "officer" as defined in s. 943.10(14),  or is a law enforcement officer of the United States Government, while such local, state, or federal officer is engaged in her or his official duties,  or when performing off-duty  as a security officer provided such activity is ~~activities~~ approved by her or his superiors.

13           (f) Be a citizen or permanent legal resident alien of the  
14 United States or have appropriate ~~been granted~~ authorization  
15 issued to seek employment in this country by the United States  
16 ~~Bureau of~~ Citizenship and Immigration Services of the United  
17 States Department of Homeland Security.

18           1. An applicant for a Class "C," Class "CC," Class "D,"  
19 Class "DI," Class "E," Class "EE," Class "M," Class "MA," Class  
20 "MB," Class "MR," or Class "RI" license who is not a United  
21 States citizen must submit proof of current employment  
22 authorization issued by Citizenship and Immigration Services or  
23 proof that she or he is deemed a permanent legal resident alien  
24 by Citizenship and Immigration Services.

25           2. An applicant for a Class "G" or Class "K" license who is  
26 not a United States citizen must submit proof that she or he is  
27 deemed a permanent legal resident alien by Citizenship and  
28 Immigration Services, together with additional documentation  
29 establishing that she or he has resided in the state of  
30 residence shown on the application for at least 90 consecutive  
31 days before the date that the application is submitted.

32           3. An applicant for an agency or school license who is not  
33 a United States citizen or permanent legal resident alien must  
34 submit documentation issued by Citizenship and Immigration  
35 Services stating that she or he is lawfully in the United States  
36 and is authorized to own and operate the type of agency or  
37 school for which she or he is applying. An employment  
38 authorization card issued by Citizenship and Immigration  
39 Services is not sufficient documentation.
