(ee) To develop and implement mechanisms to ensure that certain populations are exempt from mandatory enrollment in a Medicaid reform plan until specialized networks that have the capacity to serve these populations are developed and evaluated. The exempt populations include persons who have developmental disabilities as defined by s. 393.063(9), children found to be dependent pursuant to s. 39.01(14), adults who have serious mental illness as defined in s. 1912(c) of the Public Health



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13 Service Act, recipients who meet the institutional level of care
14 required for Medicaid nursing home care or enrollment in a
15 Medicaid home and community-based waiver program, and recipients
16 who are eligible for Medicaid pursuant to ss. 409.903(5) and
17 (8), and ss. 409.904(2), (4), (5), and (9). Any future
18 enrollment of these exempt groups requires legislative
19 authorization.
