SB 84

Basic Rights

by Senator Sobel

Proposes an amendment to the State Constitution to eliminate authority granted to the Legislature by a constitutional amendment adopted in 1926 which allowed the Legislature to regulate or eliminate the real property rights of individuals based on race or national origin. The Florida Constitution will now state that all natural persons, female and male alike, are equal before the law and have an inalienable right to acquire, possess, and protect property, without exception.
