SB 218

Medical Expenses of Inmates
Paid by a County or Municipality
by Senator Jones

Provides that absent a formal written agreement between a county or municipality and a provider, any payments made by the county or municipality under this act to the provider for medical care, treatment, hospitalization, and transportation of an arrested person shall be made at the state's Medicaid rate for such services.
