

## **SENATE BILL SUMMARY**

### SB 252 Noose/Public Display by Senator Wilson

Prohibits a person from placing a noose or causing a noose to be placed in a public place or on the property of another without first obtaining the written permission of the owner or occupier of the property. Prohibits a person from placing a noose or causing a noose to be placed in an exhibit of any kind with the intention of intimidating another person, preventing another person from doing any act that is lawful, or causing another person to do any act that is unlawful. Provides circumstances under which the provisions of the act apply. Provides that a person who violates the act commits a misdemeanor of the first degree. Provides criminal penalties.
