SB 300

Officer Andrew Widman Act/Pretrial Proceedings  
by Senator Bennett

Provides that at the first appearance of a probationer or an offender on community control arrested for a new offense for which the court finds the existence of probable cause, the court may order pretrial detention or pretrial release of the person with or without bail to await further hearing to determine the outcome of a violation hearing. Provides for dismissal of the order regarding pretrial detention or pretrial release on the uncharged violation of probation or community control if no affidavit alleging a violation of probation or community control is filed with the court within 10 days after arrest for the new offense. Provides that these provisions do not apply to a probationer or community controllee subject to a required hearing on his or her danger to the community. (See bill for details)
