SB 468 Child Abuse/False Reports by Senator Hill

Provides that a child may not be held in a shelter for more than 3 days following a determination that the order for shelter placement was based on a false report and no other instance of abuse, neglect, or abandonment was found during the protective investigation resulting from the report. Requires the child to be returned to the custody of the parent or legal custodian from whom the child was removed. (See bill for details)
