SB 796 Injunctions for Protection by Senator Hill

Requires if the petitioner has requested notification and has registered a telephone number or e-mail address with the sheriff, the sheriff shall notify the petitioner that the respondent has been served with the injunction for protection against domestic violence. Requires that this notification occur within 12 hours after the sheriff or other law enforcement officer has made service upon the respondent and the sheriff has been so notified.

Provides that the notification must include the date, time, and location where the injunction for protection against domestic violence was served.

Requires the same notification for injunctions for protection against repeat violence, sexual violence, or dating violence. (See bill for details)
