

SENATE BILL SUMMARY

SB 1106 Credit Cards/Fraudulently Taking or Using by Senator Crist

Provides that it is a felony of the third degree for a person to engage in any of the following:

- take a credit card from the possession, custody, or control of another without the cardholder's consent
- with the knowledge that it has been taken without the cardholder's consent, to possess, receive, or retain custody of the credit card or
- with the knowledge that it has been taken without the cardholder's consent, to receive such credit card with the intent to use it, sell it, or transfer it to a person other than the issuer or the cardholder.

Provides increased criminal penalties. (See bill for details)
