

## **SENATE BILL SUMMARY**

### SB 1218 Information Technology by Senator Ring

Creates the Task Force on Business Process Transformation. Assigns the task force to the Agency for Enterprise Information Technology in the Executive Office of the Governor. Provides that the task force shall perform specified duties, including, but not limited to, the following:

- conduct an inventory of all state government business process systems that are designed to support public services directly funded and delivered by state employees through state agencies or indirectly through contract vendors or other governmental entities
- solicit and receive input from subject-matter experts from the various public and private sectors affected by the actions of state government
- recommend collaborative undertakings that permit best practices to be scaled across multiple agencies to achieve the maximum impact and economies of scale
- recommend funding approaches that eliminate duplication and provide long-term investment opportunities as technology improvements and innovations dictate.
