

SENATE BILL SUMMARY

SB 1246 Elections/Absentee Ballots by Senator Justice

Provides that one request shall be deemed sufficient to receive an absentee ballot for all future elections, unless the elector or the elector's designee indicates the desire to receive the absentee ballot only for specific elections. Provides an exception for federal postcard applications.

Specifies that requests for an absentee ballot may be considered canceled when any first-class mail sent by the supervisor to the elector is returned as undeliverable. Provides for cancellation when the elector notifies the supervisor in person or in writing that he or she no longer wishes to receive an absentee ballot. (See bill for details)
