SB 1290
State Park Fees
by Senator Dean

Authorizes the Division of Recreation and Parks of the Department of Environmental Protection to waive the entrance fee to state parks on weekdays, except for weekdays that are also state holidays. Provides for such fees to be waived for state residents who are at least 62 years of age or older and who possess a state driver's license or state identification card.

Reduces the activity fees at state parks 50 percent for state residents who are at least 62 years of age or older and who possess a state driver's license or state identification card. (See bill for details)
