SB 1354  
Florida Civil Rights Hall of Fame  
by Senator Hill

Provides for the establishment of the Florida Civil Rights Hall of Fame. Directs the Department of Management Services to set aside an appropriate public area of the Capitol and to consult with the Florida Commission on Human Relations regarding the design and theme of such area.

Directs the commission to annually accept nominations for persons to be recommended as members of the hall of fame. Provides that the commission shall recommend 10 persons from which the Governor shall select up to three hall-of-fame members. (See bill for details)
