SUMMARY OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE ACTION

Page 1

The Conference Committee Amendment for CS/SB 1782, relating to the Unemployment Compensation Claims and Benefits Information System, provides for the following:

- creates s. 443.113, FS, to provide substantive statutory authority for the replacement of the UC Claims and Benefits technology system.
- establishes and defines the project's:
 - governance structure,
 - planned scope,
 - main business objectives that must be achieved, and
 - completion timeframes.

The effective date of the bill is July 1, 2009.
