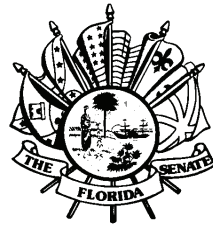

### POLICY AND STEERING COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS [WPSC] GROUPING

#### **CS/CS/SB 644 (3R) by the Committees on Transportation and Economic Development Appropriations, Governmental Oversight and Accountability and Senator Justice—**

**Direct-support Org./Department of Military Affairs;** Authorizes the direct-support organization to support the processing of requests from the Soldiers and Airmen Assistance Program or similar programs. Requires the direct-support organization to submit its annual budget and financial reports to the DMA. Requires the financial committee of the board of directors of the direct-support organization for the DMA to review the financial transactions of the program quarterly, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2010.

#### **CS/CS/SB 350 (3R) by the Committees on General Government Appropriations, Agriculture and Senator Dean—**

**Tomato Food Safety;** Requires minimum food safety standards for producing, harvesting, packing, and repacking tomatoes. Authorizes the DOACS to inspect tomato farms, greenhouses, and packinghouses or repackers. Provides a presumption that tomatoes introduced into commerce are safe for human consumption under certain circumstances. Revises duties of the Division of Fruit and Vegetables for tomato food safety inspections, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2010.

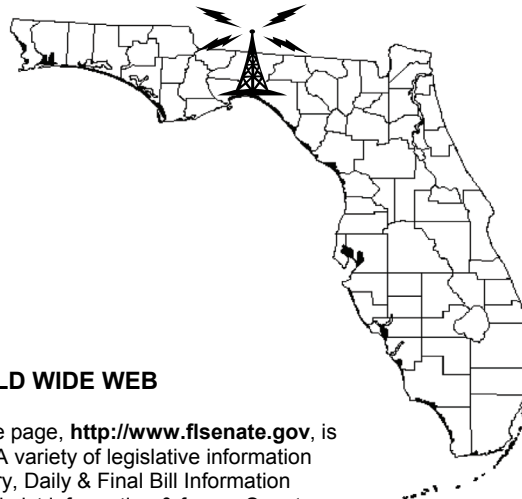
