The Policy and Steering Committee on Ways and Means (Altman) recommended the following:

Senate Amendment

Delete lines 180 - 222
and insert:

Trust Fund as required by this paragraph.

3. Penalties to be assessed and collected by the department, a county, or a municipality are as follows:

a. One hundred and fifty-eight dollars for a violation of s. 316.074(1) or s. 316.075(1)(c)1. when a driver fails to stop at a traffic signal and when enforced by the department's traffic infraction enforcement officer. One hundred and three dollars shall be distributed to the General Revenue Fund, \$45

13 shall be distributed to the county for any violations occurring
14 in any unincorporated areas of the county or to the municipality
15 for any violations occurring in the incorporated boundaries of
16 the municipality in which the infraction occurred, and \$10 shall
17 be remitted to the Department of Revenue for deposit into the
18 Department of Health Administrative Trust Fund for distribution
19 as provided in s. 395.4036(1).

20 b. One hundred and fifty-eight dollars for a violation of
21 s. 316.074(1) or s. 316.075(1)(c)1. when a driver fails to stop
22 at a traffic signal and when enforced by a county or municipal
23 traffic infraction enforcement officer. Seventy five dollars
24 shall be retained by the county or municipality issuing the
25 notification, \$73 shall be distributed to the General Revenue
26 Fund, and \$10 shall be remitted to the Department of Revenue for
27 deposit into the Department of Health Administrative Trust Fund
28 for distribution as provided in s. 395.4036(1).
